



COVID-19 Testing Resources for Faculty and Staff

The state of Connecticut is not requiring universities to test faculty and staff for COVID-19, however, faculty and staff enrolled in the university's medical plan can get a COVID-19 test at no cost to them, regardless of whether they are symptomatic or asymptomatic. Any employee who feels the need to be tested is encouraged to do so. Anthem has waived copays and cost shares for COVID-19 testing for employees & dependents covered under Quinnipiac's medical plans. Following are some additional resources to help make it easy for you to find a COVID-19 testing location or provider:

Griffin Hospital

Quinnipiac has partnered with Griffin Hospital as a preferred COVID-19 testing location to give our employees convenient access to testing. This is a PCR test, which is very accurate and is performed by a nasal swab (quick circles inside your nose). Results are ready within 24—48 hours. Call Center hours are 8AM – 3PM M – F. Call 203-437-6815, request call-back and advise you are a Quinnipiac Employee.

CIC Health *(Free, no insurance needed)*

A new COVID-testing site is open at the former Gateway Community College site at 60 Sargent Drive. Run by CIC Health, the drive-up site allows people to self-administer a nasal swab. The PCR test is paid for by the state and does not require insurance. It is open 8 a.m. to 7:45 p.m. Monday to Friday and noon to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Community Health Center, Inc. (CHCI) *(Free, no insurance needed)*

CHCI is making COVID-19 testing available for FREE at multiple drive-up or walk-up locations throughout Connecticut. You do not need to have any symptoms to be tested and an order from a healthcare practitioner is not required. You will not be asked for insurance information. A CHCI clinician will perform a deep nasal swab test and results will be available in 2-3 business days. No appointment is necessary.
