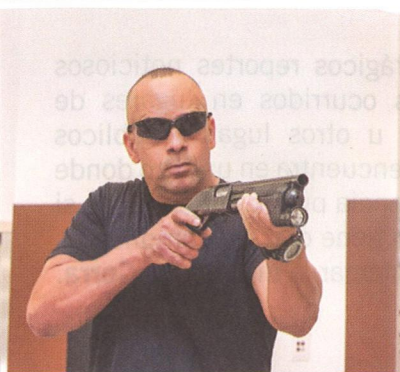


RUN > HIDE > FIGHT

>>> SURVIVING AN ACTIVE SHOOTER EVENT



From time to time, there are tragic news reports about random shooting incidents happening where we work, on school campuses, or other populated public places. If you were ever to find yourself in the middle of an active shooter event, your survival may depend on whether or not you have a plan. The plan doesn't have to be complicated. There are three things you could do that may make a difference: **Run. Hide. Fight.**

RUN.

RUN: IF AN ACTIVE SHOOTER IS IN YOUR VICINITY

- Evacuate regardless of whether others want to leave or not
- Leave your belongings behind
- Help others escape if possible
- Prevent others from entering the area where an active shooter may be
- Call 9-1-1 when you are safe

HIDE.

HIDE: IF EVACUATION IS NOT POSSIBLE

- Act quickly and quietly
- Lock and/or blockade the door
- Silence your cell phone
- Hide behind large objects
- Remain very quiet
- Your hiding place should be out of the shooter's view, provide protection if shots are fired in your direction and not trap or restrict your options for movement

FIGHT.

FIGHT: AS A LAST RESORT, AND ONLY WHEN YOUR LIFE IS IN IMMINENT DANGER

- Attempt to incapacitate the shooter
- Act with physical aggression
- Improvise weapons
- Commit to your actions

IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY PUBLIC SAFETY OR LAW ENFORCEMENT

- Call **911** from your cell phone
- Call **911** from a campus phone
- Rave Guardian

WHAT YOU NEED TO REPORT

- Your location; Area, Building, Room #, etc.
- Number of people at your location

INFORMATION ABOUT THE SUSPICIOUS PERSON

- Location, and number of individuals with suspicious person if any
- Race, gender, and physical features
- Description, color and style of clothing they are wearing
- Description of any weapons observed
